### The Dissemination and Acceptability of the ZSCMSTs VMGO

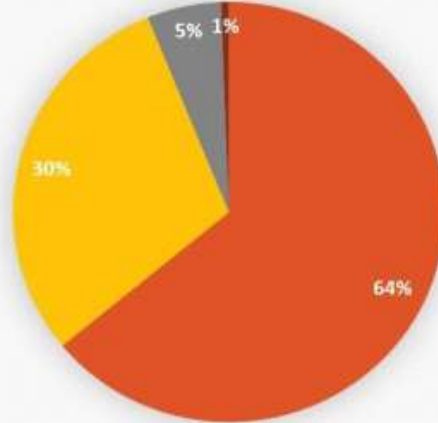
VMGO Dissemination and Acceptability Questionnaires were distributed last September 2022. It was circulated to measure the awareness, understanding and acceptability of the VMGO. The survey was partaken by different participants: **students enrolled in the College of Fisheries and Marine Sciences (CFMS), alumni of the institution, parents, and even stakeholders** of the Zamboanga State College of Marine Sciences and Technology (ZSCMST): **LGU Officials of Zamboanga City, BFAR IX representatives, and members of the Community of Barangay Mampang and Rio Hondo.** The survey was conducted and the results of the survey was processed using the MS Excel application. Based on the results of the survey, the participants were aware of the VMGO and they also understood and accepted the Vision and Mission of the ZSCMST, Goals of the CFMS and Objectives/Outcomes of the different programs of the college.

Results on the **Awareness of the Vision and Mission** shows that 64% of the participants STRONGLY AGREE, 30% AGREE, 5% are NEUTRAL, and 1% DISAGREE that they are aware of the Vision and Mission statements of the institution. The results of the Survey on the **Understanding and Acceptability of the Vision and Mission** are as follows: 57% STRONGLY AGREES, 37% AGREES, and 6% are NEUTRAL that they understand and accept the Vision and Mission of ZSCMST. Lastly, the results on the survey of the **Awareness of the Goals of College of Fisheries and Marine Sciences (CFMS) and Program Objectives** concludes that 58% STRONGLY AGREES, 37% AGREES, and 5% are NEUTRAL that they are aware of the Goals of the College of Fisheries and Marine Sciences (CFMS) and Program Objectives/Outcomes.

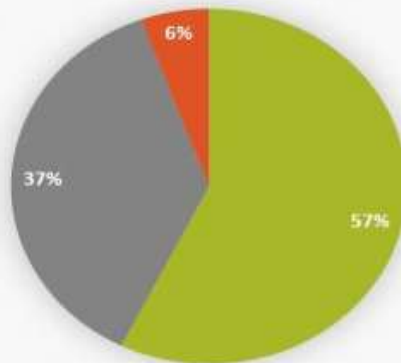


RESULTS OF THE SURVEY ON THE AWARENESS OF THE VISION AND MISSION



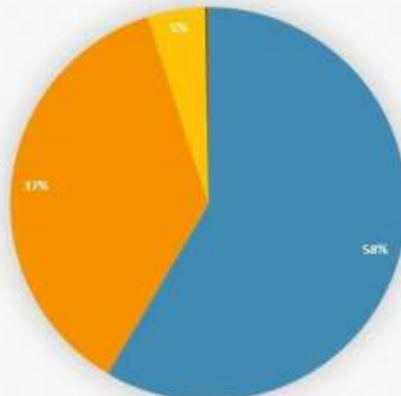


